**Headquarters Martial Law Administrator Zone 'B'**  
**Martial Law Order No.2 92**

1. (1) This Martial law order shall extend to whole of Zone 'B'
- (2) It shall come into force at once.

2. The Provisions of this Martial Law Ordcr shall take elect not withstanding

anything inconsistent therewith contained in the North-West Frontier Province \Wildiife (Protection, Preservation, C Conservation and Management) Act 1975 (N.W.F.P. ActV of 1975).

3. No person shall hunt, kill or capture by any means any four-legged wild

animal, except hare and wild boar, for a period of three years commencing from the coming into force of this Martial Law Order.

4. (1) No person shall hunt, kill or capture by any means any game bird, except  
black partridge, grey partridge, see-see, chakor, waterfowl (excluding swan),  
cranes and othcrmigratorv birds including sand grouse, quail, starlings,  
doves, and pigeons but excludng houbára bustard.

(2) The gaming of the birds permissible under sub-paragraph (1) shall be

subjected to the following conditions:

- a) Hunting shall be allowed by gun only and shall be subject to possessing of small game shooting licence obtained from the Wildlife Wing of the NWFP Forest

Department at the prescribed annual fee.

b) Hunting of waterfowl and other migratory birds will be permissible from 1st September to 15th April, only.

c) Hunting of black partridge, grey partridge, chakor and sec-sec will be permissible from first Friday of November to the last Friday of February on Fridays and gazetted holidays only in such area as Government may, from time to time specify For the shooting season from 1st November, 1981 to 1st March, 1982, shooting of these birds will be allowed in the following Tehsils/Sub-divisions only.

5. No person shall possess, buy or sell any wild animal or game bird including black partridge, grey partridge chakor and sec-sec and all licenses issued for possession of these birds shall be deemed to have been cancelled. The persons already in possession of these birds shall dispose of these birds within 15 days issue of this order.

6. No person shall deal in meat or trophies of any wild animal or bird as profession, trade or business.
7. No person shall capture or possess by any means hawks for any purpose whatsoever including hawking. All licences issued for possession of hawk shall be deemed to have been cancelled with immediate effect and persons already in possession of hawks shall dispose them of within 15 days issue of this order.
8. Whosoever contravenes or attempts to contravene or abets the contravention of any of the provisions of this Martial Law Order shall be punishable under Martial Law Regulation No.14 with rigorous imprisonment for a term which may extend to five years. forfeiture of the property and/or whipping not exceeding twenty stripes and/or fine.
9. The following Martial Law Orders, issued by the Martial Law Administrator, Zone B are hereby repealed:

  - d) Martial Law Order No.238
